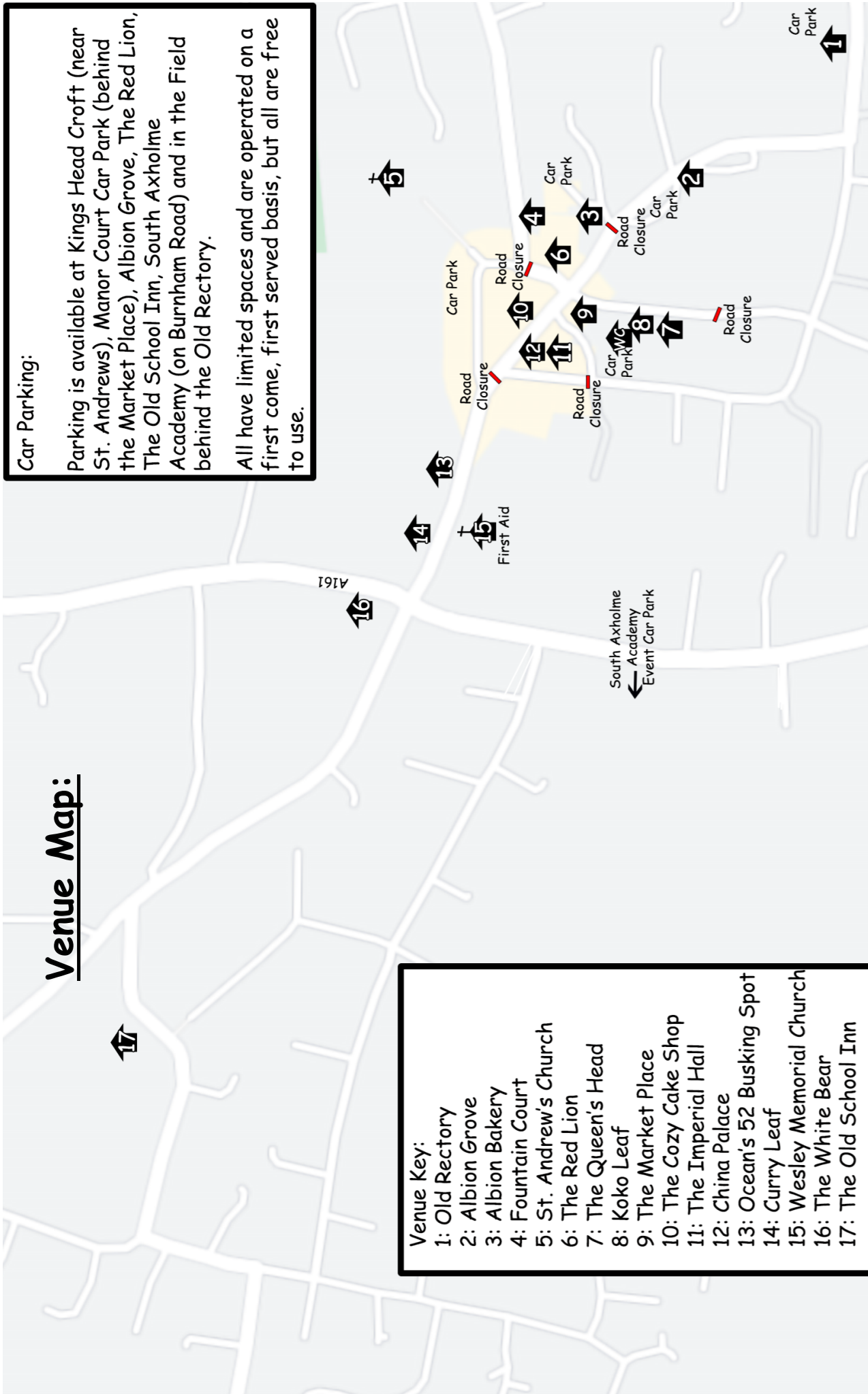
Over 60 performers across 17 venues, ready to entertain you from 10am. More information about our performers is available online on our Website, Facebook and Youtube Channels (details on back page).

Other Day Time Venues:

In addition to the 11 timetabled venues there will also be:

- **a Busking Spot** from **10:00am-16:00hrs** outside **Oceans 52 Fish and Chip Shop** - Any budding artist may sign their name upon the board in any of the 40 minute slots available at that venue and perform for the passers by between those specified hours.
- **The Red Lion** will be hosting a **'Songs Session'** from **13:00hrs until 16:00hrs**. All are welcome.
- **Cozy Café** will be having a **'Tunes Session'** from **13:00hrs until 17:00hrs in their Garden area**. All are welcome.

Evening Concerts/Activities – Free Admission

After the music stops in the streets, the festivities continue at various venues until late into the evening.
